From there, ride a north-bound bus bound for Pagadian or Ipil and get off at Panubigan crossing. From the crossing, ride a habal-habal to the barangay hall, which is where you need to register.
	Once Islas	Whole day	Entrance fee - P100/pax Environmental fee - P100/pax Boat rental fee - P1200 to P2000 (good up to 9 pax) Local guide fee - P300 per group	Island hopping is open for day tours only, from 7AM to 3PM so make sure to get there early. Tours are open daily except Fridays. You need to book in advance since tourists are limited to 200 a day only. On your booked date, proceed to Barangay Panubigan and register at the city tourism office. From there, just walk to the port where a boat will fetch you for island hopping.
